TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - TERRY STREET, SURRY HILLS

The City will be temporarily closing the road in Terry Street, Surry Hills between Foveaux Street and Kippax Street, Surry Hills.

Details of the work is as follows:

Street: Terry Street

Section: Foveaux Street to Kippax Street

Description of Work: Shared zone, footpath renewal and paving

Start Date: 18 March 2024

Closure Period: 21 March to 18 April 2024

Working Hours: 7.30am to 5.30pm – Monday to Friday

7.30am to 3.30pm - Saturday

The footpath on Foveaux Street between Terry and Elizabeth Streets will be renewed during the night between 8pm and 5am from 18 to 25 March 2024.

Access to properties via a detour will be maintained during these periods, with local residents/occupants being permitted to access their properties with traffic control assistance. Your co-operation in making alternative arrangements where possible will assist us in a swift return to normal conditions.

The closure of the lane will not be continuous but only when construction needs to take place to progress work. Normal conditions will be in place for as long as possible.

The City will take all steps to minimise impacts however; there may be machinery noise, temporary restrictions to traffic movements and parking and alternative pedestrian access. We appreciate your cooperation during this period.

In the event of bad weather, the City's contractors will try to start the work the following day. If unsuitable weather continues, we will notify you of a change in date.
