## Cycling Improvements - Kelly and Mary Ann Streets, Ultimo

We will soon start work to install a separated cycleway along Kelly and Mary Ann Streets, Ultimo. These works will improve cycle access while increasing community safety and greening of our streets.

Type of work: Installation of a separated cycleway, new pedestrian and cyclist

priority crossing on Mary Ann Street, Traffic signal upgrades at Kelly and Wattle Streets, and Mary Ann and Harris Streets, Access

ramps, Garden beds

Start date: 6 March 2024

**Working hours:** 7:30am to 5:30pm - Monday to Friday

7:30am to 3:30pm - Saturday

Some night work will be required, and further notification will be provided to the community prior to any night work.

Works will commence in Kelly Street and then progress across Wattle Street and along Mary Ann Street. All works will be completed within six months, weather permitting

We will work to minimise impacts during this time, however there will be some machinery noise, temporary restrictions to vehicle parking and changes to pedestrian access.

If there is wet weather, our contractors will try to start the work the next day. If unsuitable weather continues, we will update you on any changes to the schedule.

You will still be able to access properties in the street, and we will contact you if we need to temporarily restrict access to progress work.

Thank you for your patience while we complete these important works.
