George Street Pedestrianisation – Hunter to Bridge Streets

We will soon start work on behalf of the City of Sydney to close George Street to vehicles between Hunter Street and Bridge Street, Sydney, creating new pedestrian areas.

We will add colour and seating to the space to encourage people to use the area and support local businesses.

To manage the safety requirements working next to the light rail tracks, these works will need to be done at night, when the light rail is not operating.

Street:	George Street
Section:	Hunter Street to Bridge Street
Type of work:	Demolish traffic island, asphalt roadway, tactiles, kerb, line marking and roadway coating.
Start date:	9 January 2023
Duration:	Three weeks
Working hours:	8pm to 5am – Monday to Sunday

We will work to minimise impacts during this time. However, there may be machinery noise, temporary restrictions to traffic parking and changes to pedestrian access.

If there is bad weather, our contractors will try to start the work the next day. If unsuitable weather continues, we will update you on any changes to the schedule.
