## Improving Crown Street, Surry Hills

### Upcoming work in your street

As notified on 20 June 2023, we will soon start works to improve Crown Street between Oxford Street and Devonshire Street, Surry Hills.

Our upgrade will make Crown Street greener, help increase passing trade for local businesses and make it easier for people to walk and ride. We will install upgraded footpaths, new garden beds, alfresco dining spaces, new lighting, around 40 more trees and 10 new parking spaces. The first section of work will be between Oxford Street and Campbell Street, Surry Hills.

<b>Street:</b>	Crown Street
<b>Section:</b>	Oxford Street to Campbell Street including the side streets/laneways as they intersect with Crown Street.
<b>Type of work:</b>	Street improvements including footpath upgrades, footpath widening, underground utilities/services relocations, drainage improvements, road improvements, lighting and landscaping works.
<b>Start date:</b>	<b>Monday 17 July 2023, weather permitting</b>
<b>Duration:</b>	<b>Up to six months</b> , with work locations moving in sections between western and eastern sides of Oxford Street
<b>Working hours:</b>	Works will take place from <b>7am to 5:30pm on weekdays</b> and <b>7am to 3:30pm on Saturdays</b> .

Some works at intersections may take place at night. Advanced notification about any night works required will be provided to directly impacted residents and businesses.

#### What to expect during construction work

The City's contractor, Sydney Civil will take steps to minimise potential impacts. However, there will be machinery noise, temporary restrictions to vehicle parking and temporary alternative pedestrian access.

We will also erect temporary fencing and install water-filled barriers to create a safe working area for our construction team and the community.

In the event of wet weather or other delays, work will commence the following day. If unsuitable weather or other delays continues, we will notify of the change in scheduling. Please subscribe to receive email updates.

Sydney Civil will also provide temporary site amenities for our workers at the north-west corner of Foveaux Street near Crown Street (opposite Norton Street), Surry Hills. The site office will be installed at night via mobile crane and delivery trucks in mid-July, weather permitting.

The site amenities will operate from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **7am to 4pm on Saturdays**. We will notify local residents and businesses if we need to work outside these times at the site office to support any required night works.
