

Crown Street Upgrade

Construction Update 2 | June 2024

Our upgrade will make Crown Street greener, help increase passing trade for local businesses and make it easier for people to walk and ride. We will install upgraded footpaths, new garden beds, alfresco dining, new lighting, around 40 more trees and 10 new parking spaces.

Work completed to date

Since January 2024, we have completed footway upgrades at the following locations, with some finishing works currently underway during June:

- Campbell Street to Albion Street (both sides) with traffic signal works remaining near Crown Street Public School and northbound bus stop relocation near Campbell Street (south)
- Crown Street at Clifton Reserve
- Davies Street to Devonshire Street (east).

Thank you to everyone for their patience and cooperation during construction work.

Three month lookahead – June to September 2024

In an effort to minimise construction impacts for businesses during busy summer trading period, the next sections of Crown Street to be upgraded are:

- Foveaux Street to Albion Street (east)
- Foveaux Street to Collins Street (east) nearby Shannon Reserve
- Intersection of Goulburn Street (west) and intersection of Little Oxford Street (east).

We will continue to notify businesses and residents in advance of upcoming work.

From mid-June 2024: Foveaux Street to Albion Street (west) – moving north

- Site set up including parking removal, fencing installation, materials/equipment storage and tree protection installation
- Demolition of kerb and gutter (in sections)
- Trenching to install underground stormwater drainage line (in sections)
- Build new kerb and gutter, drainage pits
- Build new raised footway of Fitzroy Street (east)
- Demolition of footpath (in sections)
- Build new footpath with concrete base and paved finish (in sections).
- Minor finishing works, materials/equipment and fencing removal.

From mid-June 2024: Foveaux Street to Collins Street (east) along Shannon Reserve

- Site set up including parking removal, fencing installation, materials/equipment storage and tree protection installation
- Demolition of kerb and gutter (in sections)
- Trenching to install underground power and stormwater drainage line (in sections), removal of power poles

- Build new kerb and gutter, drainage pits
- Demolition of footpath (in sections)
- Build new footpath with concrete base and paved finish (in sections)
- Planting new street trees and garden beds
- Installing new smartpoles, signage and linemarking
- Minor finishing works, materials/equipment and fencing removal.

From July 2024: Intersections of Goulburn Street and Little Oxford Street

- Site set up including parking removal, fencing installation, materials/equipment storage and tree protection installation
- Trenching to install underground power connections and remove power poles, in partnership with Ausgrid
- Install new street trees, clean and seal pavers and install smartpoles

Temporary traffic changes

Throughout our work there are temporary parking, access and traffic changes on Crown Street and side streets to create safe work environment for our workers and the community. Traffic control and signage will be in place. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers. Traffic changes across the next three months includes:

- Temporary parking removal (in sections)
- Temporary footpath closures with temporary detours
- Temporary parking lane changes
- Temporary relocation of bus stops.

Shannon Reserve footway upgrade

We are starting soon to upgrade the footway from Foveaux Street to Collins Street along Shannon Reserve grassed and playground areas. To create a safe working area, we will **temporarily close Crown Street facing entries to the park** with directional signage for alternative entries. Step-free access to Shannon Reserve via Foveaux Street during our works.

We will also temporarily relocate the southbound bus stop. It will be located south of Collins Street during construction works. Temporary parking removal and temporary outdoor dining area closure is required. We will consult with impacted businesses.

To further minimise potential impacts of construction work on Shannon Reserve users we will work reduced hours for noisy and disruptive construction activities on **Saturdays (7:30am to 3:30pm)**.

Standard construction hours

Construction work will be carried out generally during the day between **7:30am and 5:30pm Monday to Friday** and **7:30am to 3:30pm on Saturdays**. We aim to minimise night works as much as possible, however, if night work is required, we will provide notification in advance to nearby residents and businesses.
